### TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT

Agreement, made this 19 day of January, 2021, by and between the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas acting for and on behalf of University of Arkansas, Fayetteville campus, 1125 W. Maple Street, 210 Administration Building, Fayetteville, AR 72701 (hereinafter referred to as "University"), and City of Cherokee Village, 2 Santee Dr, Cherokee Village, AR 72529, (hereinafter referred to as "Cherokee Village").

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Cherokee Village desires to engage the University to perform a Technical Assistance Project to prepare a cultural asset map, master plan, exhibition materials, and a final report for Cherokee Village; and

WHEREAS, University has personnel and facilities that would allow performance of the Technical Assistance entitled "Cultural Asset Mapping and Master Plan - City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas" as described in Exhibit I (hereinafter referred to as "Project"), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, both Cherokee Village and University consider it desirable and in the public interest to perform the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1. Statement of Work and Services.

- a. Cherokee Village agrees to engage the services of University as an independent contractor to perform the Project. The Project will be under the supervision of Stephen Luoni (Project Director) at University, with the assistance of appropriate associates and colleagues at University as may be required. University agrees as an independent contractor to perform the Project. Such Project was originally approved by University in accordance with University policy and may be subsequently amended only in accordance with University policy and the written agreement of University and Cherokee Village.
- b. University shall commence the performance of Project promptly after the effective date of this Agreement, and shall use its best efforts to perform such Project in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- c. In the event that the Project Director becomes unable or unwilling to continue Project and a mutually acceptable substitute is not available, and the University thereby is unable to complete Project in accordance with this Agreement, University and/or Cherokee Village shall have the option to terminate said Project.
- d. Written program reports shall be provided by University to Cherokee Village as mutually agreed to by the parties to this Agreement.
- 2. Award and Payment. Cherokee Village agrees to pay University sixty-five thousand and one and NO/100 Dollars (\$65,000) on a cost reimbursable basis for expenses and other related costs incurred in conjunction with the Project. This cost, as shown by approximate category of expense in the attached Exhibit I which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference, for information only, shall be payable upon receipt of University invoices submitted to Cherokee Village by University. University will send Cherokee Village invoices at least quarterly and no more frequently than monthly, and Cherokee

Village agrees to pay University within thirty (30) days of receipt of such invoices.

- 3. <u>Basic Term</u>. This Agreement shall become effective January 1, 2021, and unless earlier terminated as hereinafter provided, shall expire January 31, 2022.
- 4. <u>Publicity</u>. Cherokee Village will not use the name of University or of any member of University's Project staff, in any publicity, advertising, or news release without the prior written approval of University. University will not use the name of Cherokee Village nor any employee of Cherokee Village, in any publicity without the prior written approval of Cherokee Village.
- 5. <u>Responsibility</u>. The parties each agree to assume individual responsibility for the actions and omissions of their respective employees, agents and assigns in conjunction with this Project.
- 6. <u>Indemnification</u>. Cherokee Village shall indemnify and hold harmless University, its trustees, officers, agents and employees from any liability or loss resulting from judgments or claims against them arising out of the activities to be carried out pursuant to the obligations of this Agreement or the use by Cherokee Village of the results of the Project provided, however, that the following is excluded from Cherokee Village's obligation to indemnify and hold harmless:
- a. The negligent failure of University to comply with any applicable governmental requirements; or
- b. The negligence or willful malfeasance by a trustee, officer, agent or employee of University.
- 7. <u>Default and Termination</u>. In the event that either party to this Agreement shall be in default of any of its material obligations hereunder and shall fail to remedy such default within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice thereof, the party not in default shall have the option of terminating this Agreement by giving written notice thereof, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Agreement. Termination of this Agreement shall not affect the rights and obligations of the parties that accrued prior to the effective date of termination. Cherokee Village shall pay University for all reasonable expenses incurred or committed to be expended as of the effective termination date, subject to the maximum amount as specified in Article 2.
- 8. Entire Agreement. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement and the attached Exhibit(s) hereto represent the sole and entire Agreement between the parties hereto pertaining to the Project and that such supersedes all prior Agreements, understandings, negotiations and discussions between the parties regarding the same, whether oral or written. There are no warranties, representations or other Agreements between the parties in connection with the subject matter hereof except as specifically set forth herein. No supplement, amendment, alteration, modification, waiver or termination of this Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by the parties hereto. This Agreement supersedes any other document including Cherokee Village Purchase Order(s).
- 9. <u>Notices</u>. Any notices, statements, payments, or reports required by this Agreement shall be considered given if sent by United States Certified Mail, postage prepaid and addressed as follows:

10. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the substantive laws of the State of Arkansas, without reference to its conflict of laws principles, and with applicable laws of the United States of America.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which taken together constitutes one and the same instrument. Executed agreement documents transmitted by electronic means are considered original documents. This Agreement is effective upon the date last signed and executed by the authorized representatives of the parties.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas acting for and on behalf of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville ("University") and City of Cherokee Village ("Cherokee Village") entered into a Technical Assistance Agreement No. TAA2112145 ("Agreement"), dated January 19, 2021 and effective January 1, 2021 for Cherokee Village to conduct specific activities under, and

WHEREAS, the University and Cherokee Village wish to Amend the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement may be amended as provided in Article 8 of said Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Amendment No. 1 is in keeping with the goals of the University and Cherokee Village;

NOW THEREFORE, the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

#### ARTICLE 2 - AWARD AND PAYMENT

Article 2 shall be amended by the addition of the following text:

Cherokee Village agrees to pay University additional funds in the amount of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), as shown by approximate category of expense in the attached Appendix A. Total Project funding shall not exceed dollars Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000).

#### **EXHIBIT I**

The Statement of Work in Exhibit I of the Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following text:

#### Statement of Work

The University of Arkansas Community Design Center (UACDC) will work in concert with the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, the Arts Center of North Arkansas, and various stakeholder groups in compiling research, evaluating cultural assets and leading design charrettes. UACDC will also develop Cherokee Village parcel and building footprint data files utilizing GIS technology. UACDC will prepare a cultural asset map, master plan, exhibition materials, and a final report, and provide GIS data files to the City. The final report will be visually based with renderings (aerials and eye-level experiences), drawings, and plans illustrating the master plan.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.
